<p>Key to effectively identifying an issue and ensuring that clients are matched with the most appropriate type and level of treatment.</p> <p>(WHO, 2010) states that :screening aims to detect health problems or risk factors at an early stage before they have caused serious disease or other problems and is a part of maintaining prevention practice activities in health care settings.”</p>	<p>An initial assessment identifies critical information that is used by the practitioner and client to make decisions about next steps for treatment.</p> <p>-What do you want to measure? - What do you need to know to develop appropriate treatment/wellness plans.</p>	<p>Consider where person is on the continuum of care.</p> <p>Pre-Treatment Treatment Continuing Care</p> <p>Other prompts for consideration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - appropriate stage of recovery - possible treatment topics - case management needs <p>Holistic plans of care integrate client’s needs, strengths, and supports when determining activities to achieve wellness goals.</p>	<p>A method of providing services whereby a specified worker assesses the needs of the client and the client’s family, when appropriate, and arranges, coordinates, monitors, evaluates and advocates for a package of multiple services to meet the specific client’s complex needs. Monitor = ensure supports utilized and available Goal is to help client create a meaningful and satisfactory life as is possible</p>
